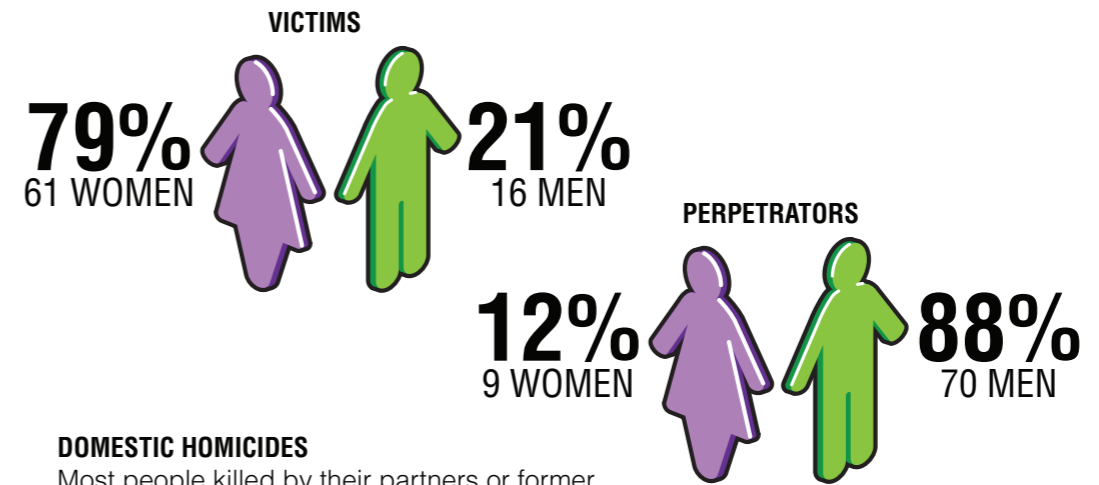


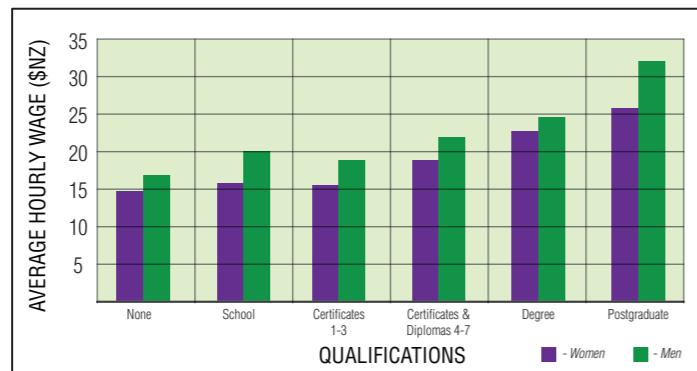
WOMEN ON BOARDS

Women make up 41.5% of people on state sector boards and committees, but only 9.3% of members of private sector boards (Top 100 companies on the stock exchange).



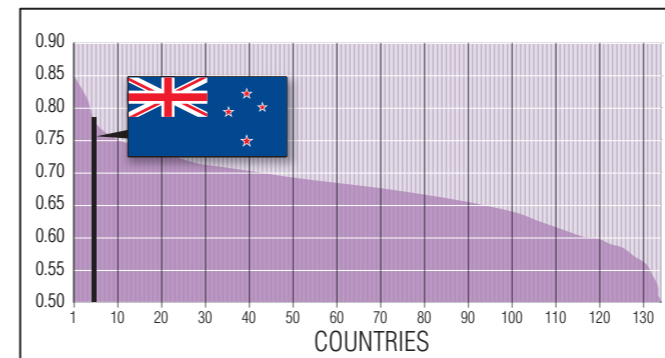
DOMESTIC HOMICIDES

Most people killed by their partners or former partners are women; most of those responsible for deaths of partners or former partners are men. Numbers are for 2002-06. 10 of the 16 men killed were perceived to be partners of the perpetrator's ex-partners.



EDUCATION DOES NOT ELIMINATE THE PAY GAP

Men are paid more, on average, than women regardless of the level of education – even though women are now graduating in larger numbers than men.
