The Ministry of Women's Affairs (MWA) uses the personal information from your Curriculum Vitae (CV) to match your skills against the requirements for appointments to government boards. These can include positions on: statutory boards, statutory trusts, committees, commissions, councils, review teams, reference groups or similar and individual nominations to a unique role where specific expertise is sought.

In the course of nominating you for suitable positions the personal information in your CV may be disclosed to:

- Ministers of the Crown, their offices, ministries and departments when candidates are being considered for appointments;
- The chairs of relevant boards or committees; and the companies/ministries/organisations if you are appointed (for administrative purposes);
- Government departments/ministries/organisations/agencies needing suitably qualified individuals for nomination to other agencies.

By signing and returning this form, you agree that:

1. MWA is entitled to release your personal information to third parties in the course of nomination, selection and appointment to government agencies.
2. MWA is entitled to collect information about you from third parties (Government agencies with a nominations function and referees).
3. You authorise those third parties to disclose information to MWA that is personal to you.
